You have the right to protection from any kind of exploitation (being taken advantage of).

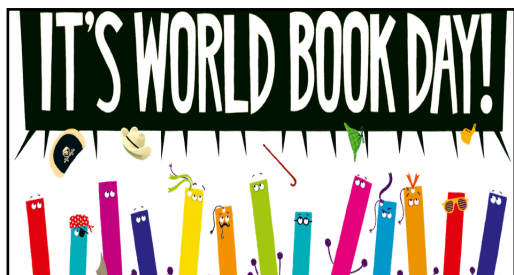
Article 40
